In optical communication systems, fiber combiners enable the combination of signals from multiple channels into a single fiber, enhancing network efficiency and capacity, especially in dense wavelength division multiplexing (DWDM) systems. Fiber combiners are integral in applications where high power. Light from an input fiber is first collimated, then sent through a beam-splitting optic to divide it into two. The resultant output beams are then focused back into the output fibers.
