The National Electrical Code Article 318 was written primarily for verifying the cable fill in cable trays but little has been done to convert this information into a design procedure. Standard for Non-Metallic Cable Tray Systems 2. Span support criteria shall be as specified (Reference the following table): 3. Nominal loading depth (as required): 2" (51mm), 3" (76mm), 5". Their design complies with most cable tray requirements and cable tray code requirements, ensuring both safety and durability. Solid-bottom cable trays offer a completely enclosed surface to support and protect cables.
