A decibel is expressed as the base 10 logarithm of the ratio of the power of two signals, as shown here: $dB = 10 \times \text{Log}_{10} (P1/P2)$ where Log_{10} is the base 10 logarithm, and P1 and P2 are the powers to be compared.
