Please cut off the power of the system before installation, maintenance, and disassembly, and make sure that the product rating (36kV and below) is consistent with the application. Check all spare parts specifications, verify the quantity is as listed, and ensure that it matches the. What are the three primary criteria for selecting a Junction Box (JB) material?

For Offshore/Coastal/Chemical environments, 316L Stainless Steel is the standard, offering superior resistance to chlorides. For General Industrial (non-corrosive) or cost-sensitive areas, painted Carbon Steel or Glass. Cold shrink technology involves using pre-stretched rubber sleeves that are placed around the cable junctions or terminations. These sleeves are designed to tightly fit around the cable once the core that keeps them expanded is removed. Typical methods and procedures employed to create safe S. cable joints on low voltage cables are described and demonstrated in the following programmes: LVJ-1 Resin Cast.
