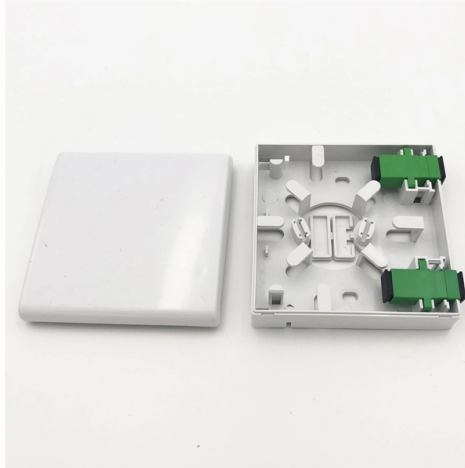


Paraguay Integrated Power Supplier

Because of the dominance of hydroelectricity, tariffs (mostly residential) are remarkably below the averages for the region.
