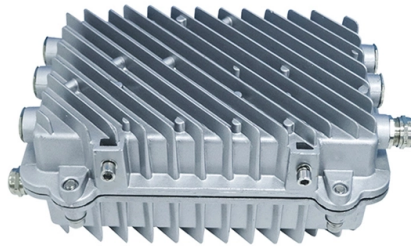


Safety Precautions During Optical Cable Testing



Overview

Safety glasses must be worn AT ALL TIMES when working with cable, fiber, and/or chemicals. Fiber ends are sharp and can easily penetrate skin and clothing. This is particularly true when the protective coating is removed. Safety glasses must conform to the guidelines expressed in the American National Standards Institute document (ANSI Z535) for hazard alert messages. Alerts are included in this instruction manual for serious injury (spectacles) conforming to ANSI Z87, for eye protection from accidental injury when handling chemicals, cables.
