Under the TIA/EIA-598-C standard, the universal 12-color sequence is: 1-Blue, 2-Orange, 3-Green, 4-Brown, 5-Slate (Gray), 6-White, 7-Red, 8-Black, 9-Yellow, 10-Violet, 11-Rose, and 12-Aqua. The fiber color code is a standardized method that assigns specific colors to fiber optic components—including outer cable jackets, individual fiber strands, and connectors—to ensure reliable identification throughout installation and maintenance.
