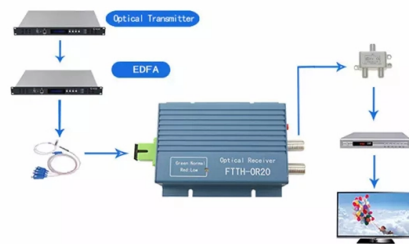


What is fiberglass hard tail material
