A Green connector indicates APC (Angled Physical Contact), polished at an 8-degree angle to. The TIA-598 standard (specifically the current 598-D revision) exists to prevent two major issues: Mode Mismatch: Plugging multimode into a single-mode port (or vice versa) causes catastrophic signal loss.
