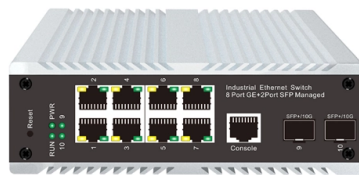


Why is single-mode fiber incident perpendicularly



Overview

Although the ray travels parallel to the length of the fiber, it is often called transverse mode since its electromagnetic oscillations occur perpendicular (transverse) to the length of the fiber. Higher-order modes like LP 11, LP 20 etc. then do not exist — only cladding modes, which are not localized around the fiber core. Note that in most cases light with different polarization states can be guided. The term “single-mode” ignores.
